## DIDCOT VICTORIOUS IN 9-UP TEAM TIME TRIAL

Phoenix once again took the Bicester Millenium 9-up ten mile time trial on the RAF Weston-on-Green perimeter course of 4 circuits with a first class ride of 22.26 in what were quite windy conditions making it a hard ride.

We only started with eight riders as we had two teams and the first five over the line was the time taken for the team. Our A team riders were: Mark Cox, Paul Lloyd, Phil Brown, Nick Druce, Angus Whitfield, Mike Cooper, Warren Bates and Henry Latimer. They rode very strongly all through the event and eventually crossed the line in first place. Our B team only consisted of five riders, putting them at a distinct four rider disadvantage. Three were ladies: Laura Wells, Catherine Bates and Amanda Druce, They were assisted by Craig Haller and guest rider Steve Avery, making a team

of just the five riders necessary for the event. They recorded a ride of 30.25 putting them in last place of the nine teams in the competition.
